Sunday, February 26, 1995

At 11:30 <sup>there</sup> was a champagne & coffee cake party Poolside for Bobbi of "Gunny Poo & Champagne Too". She is leaving after two months to return to Canada until next year. She has been coming for winters to her Houseboat here for 20 years.

Then we had lunch at Kip's Place - The Couch Inn Cafe - Mort had chicken sause a Bahaman dish with chicken, chicken broth, potatoes, onion, green pepper, lime & bird pepper (a super strong pepper that is served on the side. Mort never uses it I squeeze a drop of the juice and the whole dish is peppery.) and I had a ceaser salad. [I told you I'm on a diet.]

We laid around in the afternoon and played Rummy Tiles w/ cocktails. Dinner was mergolis of beef and asparagus.

Monday, February 27, 1995 Marsh Harbour

Not a great day. Everything went wrong for Mort including the Whaler engine failing. He was towed back from Admiral's Yacht Haven by Bill of Merius.

Things were not good for me either. The water went out, power went out, Mort was a bear. The zoo's best door continued (Dorisee, a Southern Cross 53 - Owners name Alain, a frenchman & his wife with 2 grown sons aboard, 2 pregnant daughters in laws and 5 ~~more~~ grandsons aged 7 to 3. The noise is incredible including the engines. They have severe electrical problems and run their engines day & night.)

It rained a torrent and Mort & I had a fight. I wonder why.

Dinner was the best thing that happened all day. We had cold shrimp, homemade potatoe salad, hardboiled eggs, pickled Beets & for the moment we were cordial to each other.

It didn't last, but tomorrow is another day.

I got all the salon & aft cabin pledged - that include the walls - and both the pilot house & gally floors washed, and the Salon vacuumed.

Then we had lunch.

Mort is now (it's 1:30) off to do the errands that we short circuited by the engine failure yesterday - He is doing them on foot.

While he is gone I used my knees - just as a precaution. My knees & hips have been pretty good today. This is my 9<sup>th</sup> day on Naprosyn. (Actually my knees have been pretty good for the last month. It is my hips & back that have been troublesome. If only the anti-inflammatories were not so dangerous I could really function like old time. However, I am afraid to stay on them too long.)

Neither Mort nor I will have to back into the bay window today.

We plan to do Margo's Happy hour this evening.
