f) Tuesday was my first relatively normal day. Had Elisor, Don, Marilyn & Mark for cocktails.

g) Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup>  
We are back to ourselves again. Mort vanished, I "chared" it. (Laurie, Vann, etc.) We went with Elisor, Don, Marilyn, Mark, and Linda + Jimi to Banana Bay for their Wednesday night Pig Roast. Fork, sweet & sour plantains, rice & beans, salad. Assumptious and only \$10.00 per person. We'll do that again.

Sunday November 1, 1992

Played today. Watched Football (made tape) Had Edna - Keen and Stanley over for Cocktails. Repayment of their kindness to help with the washer + dryer installation.

Monday November 2, 1992
